The Groton Municipal EFCU Board of Director's are pleased to announce the relocation of its office operations. The new home of Groton Municipal EFCU will be located at **44 Plaza Court**, Groton Shopping Plaza. The Credit Union will be in a more visible and central location bringing new opportunities for both our current and future membership.

In anticipation of the move and to take advantage of these opportunities the Credit Union has developed a new logo and tag line that will be an identifying factor in building our brand. The membership will not be inconvenienced during the move. Home Banking, MobiMoney, and your debit card will work as they normally do and experience little down time, if at all. You will be able to access your funds as you normally do apart from the early office closing on August 17, 2018.

I would like to also announce that our Acting Manager, Cheryl Dunaj, has been officially appointed as CEO/Manager. She has been a tremendous asset in making our relocation process such a success; as well as keeping our credit union functioning smoothly during this transition period.
